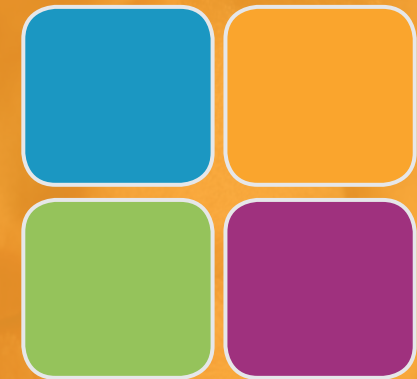

INFORMATION LEAFLET

Our Service

The Community Addictions Team (CAT) has a number of specialist practitioners to help people experiencing dependency on drugs and/or alcohol, and who may have mental health issues as well.

First assessments for tier 3 CAT are within the Community Addiction Team in St Luke's Hospital Armagh. In certain circumstances we may offer appointments for assessment in a specialist clinic in Craigavon Area Hospital. You will be invited either verbally, by phone or by appointment letter to the most appropriate venue.

Tier 2 services and other specialist services with the Community Addiction team try to arrange appointments within locality area. Please allow 1 ½ hours for initial assessment and up to 45 minutes per follow up appointment.

Follow up review appointments are generally offered within locality areas, including Newry, Kilkeel, Lurgan, Banbridge, Brownlow, Portadown, Armagh and Dungannon.
